# Why Certification?

- The process for earning the PMP is rigorous.
- It takes a lot of preparation and practical experience.
- Between 60 - 75 % of applicants pass the exam.



Certification represents achieving minimum levels of proficiency

Employers are seeking Certified applicants.

Benefit personally and professionally from the training and study required to earn a credential.

External customers value project managers being certified.

Project managers who hold the PMP certification earn more than non-certified project managers.

Their experience makes many veterans ready for the civilian project management world.


## PMI Certifications at a glance

The CAPM demonstrates your understanding of the fundamental knowledge, terminology and processes of effective project management. CAPM is the precursor to the PMP certification and also is administered by the PMI. Designed for professionals who want to achieve their PMP certification in steps rather, or for those with only rudimentary project management experience, the CAPM is a stepping-stone to the more rigorous PMP.

The PMP is the gold standard of project management certification. Recognized and demanded by organizations worldwide, the PMP validates your competence to perform in the role of a project manager, leading and directing projects and teams.

Portfolio management certification recognizes the advanced experience and skill of portfolio managers. The PfMP demonstrates your proven ability in the coordinated management of one or more portfolios to achieve organizational objectives.

The PgMP is designed for those who manage multiple, complex projects to achieve strategic and organizational results.



### CAPM®

- Secondary degree (high school diploma, associate's degree or the global equivalent)
- 1,500 hours of project experience

OR

- 23 hours of project management education completed by the time you sit for the exam

### PMP®

- Secondary degree (high school diploma, associate's degree or the global equivalent)
- 7,500 hours leading and directing projects
- 35 hours of project management education

OR

- Four-year degree
- 4,500 hours leading and directing projects
- 35 hours of project management education

# How do I complete the Certification process?

## 1. Complete Application

- Fill out an application documenting your education and project management experience, which PMI says can take as much as eight hours.
- **Tip:** To complete the application quickly, gather all of the information and documentation you need before opening it. Otherwise, it will likely take you multiple sessions to complete.

## 2. Application Review


- Review period will take 5–10 days, depending on the certification. Once it's complete, PMI will email you to move on to the next step.

## 3. Payment

- \$405 for Project Management Institute (PMI) members, non-members is \$555.

## 4. Complete computer-based test

- Pass a four-hour, 200 question exam
- **Tip:** create an exam study plan.
  - Review the certification handbook and the exam content outline — they'll explain the exam format and topics that will be covered.
  - Read current books and articles in your domain topic areas.
  - Study! Consider enrolling in an exam prep course and forming a study group with your colleagues or friends.

# Maintain Certification:

- Continuing Certification Requirements (CCR)
- After completing PMI Certification you'll need to participate in professional development activities, and earn and report professional development units (PDUs.) There are lots of ways to earn PDUs.
- 3-year cycles
- 60 PDUs needed per cycle

(Projects IN Controlled Environments (PRINCE2) Certification)

- The PRINCE2 and PMP certifications involve two different project management frameworks. Both offer a body of knowledge and a proven approach to managing projects effectively.
- The PMP certification is preferred in the USA, Canada, Middle East and Australia. PRINCE2, however, is recognized in UK, Europe, and Australia.
